

Pingelly Main Street Diversion

We have over 160 vans coming to the rally in Pingelly. The main street of Pingelly will be closed on Friday to enable the set up for the FAM Festival stalls for Saturday.

To try and avoid any major impact of so many caravans in the main streets, diversions will be in place from **Thursday morning through to Friday evening**. Please follow these. If you arrive in the main street, you may have issues with the work that is being undertaken there, so follow the diversion signs and your entry to the oval should be a simple and straight forward process.
